ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
**Point San Pedro Road Coalition**

**Article One:** The name of this corporation is the Point San Pedro Road Coalition.

**Article Two:**

(A) This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the nonprofit benefit corporation law for public and charitable purposes.

(B) The specific purpose of this corporation is to engage in charitable and educational activities within the meaning of IRC § 501(c)(3), in order to preserve the environment, neighborhoods and health of the residents and businesses of Point San Pedro Road.

**Article Three:** The name and address in this state of this corporation's initial agent for the service of process is Jonathan Frieman, 170 Oak Drive, San Rafael, CA 94901.

**Article Four:**

(A) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.

(B) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate

in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

**Article Five:** The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director or officer thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
